


Joining this Executive MBA program means that you will be surrounded by men and women of the highest caliber who won't only be classmates, but will become lifelong sources of friendship and professional support.



Application Process

Admissions Committee Evaluation

The Admissions Committees are comprised of different faculty members whose goal is to identify those profiles that not only stand out but possess trades that are in line with our school's vision.

The evaluation process is thorough and comprehensive, meaning that both qualitative and quantitative aspects of the candidate are separately taken into account.



Admission Results

Once your file is evaluated by the Admissions Committee, you will be notified of your results and get some recommendations on behalf of your admissions advisor. We encourage you to prepare your file in advance, taking into account the deadlines for the evaluation rounds.

All candidates must deliver their admissions file in full before receiving the final resolution of the Admissions Committee and acquiring their enrollment documents.
